### *A Lineage of Queensland's Naval and Military Forces 1860 - 1903*

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## **Queensland's Military and Naval Forces**

The second half of the nineteenth century was a time when the individual colonial governments exercised general control of their own defences, particularly after 1869 when the British Regular Army withdrew from the Australian continent. The Commonwealth of Australia, nominally from 1901, though effectively from 1903, then took over the role of defending the country.

The story of the Queensland military organisation is about the maintenance of a volunteer or militia force during peacetime. Throughout the four decades from its inception in 1860, the force received varying levels of support from the colonial government. During this period, particularly in the first decade, its fortunes fluctuated wildly, affected by the economic prosperity, or rather poverty, of the colony. Attempts were made by its Officers and supporters to keep the force adequate for its prescribed task of defending the colony. It would appear however, that always at the back of the minds of those with the power to disperse funds to the colonial military, was the thought that ultimately Great Britain, or at least its Royal Navy, would rescue the Australian colonies if any real danger of foreign aggression were to manifest itself.

There were war scares over the years, and on occasions the colonial military aided the civil authorities, but generally there was little sense of pressing danger. Queensland soldiers never battled to defend their own shores against a foreign foe. The force was first called out to aid the civil powers during the so-called Bread Riots of September 1866. In 1878 when Great Britain appeared on the verge of war with Russia, and the Queensland Government feared a raiding force might suddenly descend on the capital or major provincial towns, the Force was mobilised. Again in 1885, fearing an imminent war with the Russian Empire, the Defence Force was called out for active service. It was at this time that the Marine Defence Force was established. In 1891, as a result of wide-spread civil disturbances in the western districts of Queensland, the Force was again mobilised on active service. This was the largest action undertaken by the military to that date, and like previous policing actions, did not result in any bloodshed.

It has not yet been possible to accurately enumerate how many men served in the Volunteer Forces from 1860 to 1884, but in the period 1885 to 1902 approximately 20,000 men are believed to have enrolled in both the colony's naval and military forces. This does not include those who volunteered for active service in the South Africa war of 1899-1902. Nevertheless, an organisation, in which 20000 residents of the colony were members, surely deserves more attention.

Queensland's military history has been often glossed over in popular histories, however recent publications by the Colonial Forces Study Group Queensland) are seeking to rectify that situation. ### **Reading this document**

This collection documents the changes which occurred within the structure of Queensland's military and naval forces between 1860 and 1903. It provides a lineage of all the individual units which make up and contributed to the development of the Forces. It identifies these units, the changes in their designations and, where possible, what became of them when the Commonwealth of Australia took control of the colonial defence force. It does not provide a picture of the strength or effectiveness of those units during that period, such a compilation being beyond the scope of this manuscript.

The information is tabulated alphabetically under the town where the unit was established, and then arranged chronologically. Each entry contains an index code by which it is possible to track the progression of an individual unit. During their existence many units were redesignated, or given another title, often as a result of the creation of the various regiments, brigades, or military districts, or their disbandment. In some cases individual companies were moved between regiments, and in others only the name was changed. All proven changes, whether large or small, are noted here. Units, for which there is no further redesignation or a disbandment date, are ones which passed into Commonwealth control.

All dates are given in the Australian form DD/MM/YYYY. Any dates which take the form 00/00/YYYY indicated that although the year in which an event occurred is known, the specific date has not been located. The establishment date given for each unit is usually the date of notification in the Queensland Government Gazette, though sometimes it might be the date of the letter of notification before it was sent for gazettal. In most cases the difference is only one or two days. It should be noted however, that some units were in existence for months before the Government accepted their offer of service, and proceeded with the gazettal notice. Detailed Establishments of Corps were proclaimed periodically, and it is from these Establishment lists that much of the information contained here is derived. The dates for redesignations are those given under the Governor's proclamation or in the General Orders of the Queensland Defence Force. Occasionally units given on the Establishment were never raised. Where this is known to have occurred it has been noted.
